



Funding Guidelines



1. Funding from **Suffolk Sport** is only available to Suffolk Sport coaches or volunteers wanting to take ASA teaching / coaching qualifications for swimming at a Regional Education Network Centre.
2. If you are eligible for **Suffolk Sport** funding you will be awarded up to 75% of the total course fee (excluding accommodation but including assessment fee if applicable). This will include funding from the Regional ASA and Suffolk County ASA.
3. Funding is available to Swim21 accredited clubs or those clubs registered and working towards Swim 21 only.
4. All application forms must be submitted BEFORE the start of the course. Personnel within your club must also support the application
5. Upon receipt of an application form, you will receive confirmation in writing of the amount of funding to be awarded. Please ensure you have been allocated funding prior to booking on the course. Once you have confirmation of funding please book onto the course and send a cheque for the outstanding balance.
6. There will be a budget set each year by Suffolk Sport , SCASA and by Regional ASA for the total available for grants in the next year from each organisation. Grants will be available on a 'first come, first served' basis.
