Championship Secretary Report

November 2021

Due to the pandemic, it was not possible to run the County Championships in 2021.

However, lots of work went on behind the scenes in the hope that it might have been feasible. Many of these plans have informed the planning for the 2022 Championships, which is well underway.

Consideration times are in place for the 2022 Championships and, providing space allows, all swims which meet the Considerations times will be admitted. In addition, the window for qualifying has been pushed back 1st January 2020, meaning all swims from the County Championships that year fall into the window for the 2022 competition.

After consultation with clubs, the schedule for the 2022 Championships will be the typical schedule from previous years with a mix of events and distances for all swimmers across each session. The format of the relays has been changed to that all relays are mixed to help to limit the number of swimmers at the pool in the final session.

Entry packs will be available to clubs from shortly. The closing date for long distance entries is 17th December; all other entries should be submitted by 31st December.
