

Funding Guidelines

1. Funding is available to all Suffolk County ASA affiliated clubs.
2. Each club will then be allocated £1,000 from 1st October 2021 to 30th September 2022. All funding is to be spent by 30th September 2022.
4. The Funding will then be reviewed again from 1st October 2022 onwards.
5. Up to 50% funding/course is available for clubs who would like their personnel to do one of the following courses –
 - Swim England Teaching Aquatics, Coaching, Water Polo, Diving or Synchronised Swimming course
 - National Pool Lifeguard course to support club sessions
 - National Teachers Rescue Test Award
 - Recognised Land Training Courses to support these programmes for clubs
 - Officials Training
6. All application forms must be submitted by the club BEFORE the start of the course. These will be verified by the Suffolk County ASA and clubs will be reimbursed once the course is completed.
7. If clubs would prefer, the county will now consider allowing clubs to use their funding against capital projects including new starting blocks, backstroke ledges, lane ropes, and AOE up to 50% of the cost. The funding is limited and likely to be limited to a maximum of £1,700 per club.
8. Funding allocation will be for the financial year in which the course is completed.
9. All invoices for reimbursement must reach SCASA by 14th October after the end of the previous financial year.
10. Clubs will not be able to carry forward any part of their funding after the cut-off date.
